

1. First you want to mix up your brown clays. Press it out flat and cut out a rectangle shape.
2. Next you cut out the eyes and mouth of Mount Boom.
3. Taking spare clay, add on cheeks and eyebrows. Don't worry about making it smooth. Remember, Mount Boom is made of rocks!
4. After that, take an angled sculpting tool or butter knife, draw lines down the clay, mimicking Mount Booms unique rock shapes, but only lightly into the clay. Make sure to do it at varied heights on top.
5. Once you're done with the rock details, stand the clay up and wrap it around. Now he's looking like the real deal, right?
 - a. OPTIONAL STEP: Take more of the spare clay and add more rock details to the bottom of Mount Boom!
6. Next step is to bake your sculpture in the oven following the instructions of the clay you purchased for this craft.
7. Once it's cooled, add the small LED or tea-light candle to complete the craft!
